I am pleased to provide this letter of endorsement for the Golden Gate National Parks Conservancy's proposal for the Presidio Commissary site, and for the programs envisioned by the Presidio Exchange (PX).

As one of Northern California's leading institutions providing informal science education to students, CommunityGrows knows how an institution whose programs are rooted in history, nature, and science can give important lift to the experiences of those students in the classroom. The Parks Conservancy – through thoughtful partnerships with park partners and schools – is known and respected in the Bay Area for its work to create these experiences in the national parks, and especially at the Presidio.

We have enjoyed over the years all the opportunities the GGNPC has provided our youth, including park stewardship days, Camping in the Presidio for our teens, National Holiday celebrations such as Earth Day, visits to Crissy Field Center, and much more. Our at-risk teens especially enjoy all the opportunities to get away from their neighborhoods and go to the Conservancy's park programs right in the City. The proposal envisioned by PX would enrich and compliment all these programs, and the youth of this City will rejoice many fold!

Stemming from this, we believe the Parks Conservancy's PX proposal is, by far, the best fit for the site. In addition to supporting the connection of school children and young people to their parks, the PX will be a tremendous resource to families from local communities and from around the world, providing workshops, performances, exhibits and ties to park-wide programs that draw from its national park setting.

The recent government shutdown exemplified how important the national parks are to the American public. To select an entity for the Commissary site that has no tangible role in this relationship would be a missed opportunity.
